Academic and Spiritual Development

Our Christian Vision Statement focuses on the importance of every child achieving their full potential: 'Rooted in the Christian faith, and with a love of learning in our hearts, our vision inspires us to grow into the people God is calling us to be'. Driven by our Vision Statement we believe that children are entitled to a broad and rich curriculum which provides opportunities for new experiences and taps into children's potential. Our curriculum continues to evolve and to be broad and balanced; as part of this the school uses additional provision, including external experts, to support and further enhance the learning experience of our pupils.

Worship is Anglican, inclusive and outward looking. Members of our community are invited to join us in Worship both at school and at St Nicholas' Church particularly for special services such as Eucharist. Prayer and times for reflection take place during Worship, before lunch and at the end of the school day, which provide the children with opportunities for individual spiritual development. Children also have opportunities to develop their spirituality by exploring the natural world through timetabled sessions in the Forest Area, Peace Gardens and to take part in drama activities in the school amphitheatre.
