

Pupil Premium Analysis 2017/18 (as part of the data review 2018)

Headlines for Whole School

Attainment

- In Reading 81.8% are heading or higher than expectation for their year group.
- In Writing 63.6% are heading or higher than expectation for their year group.
- In Mathematics 72.7% are heading or higher than expectation for their year group.

The focus clearly needs to be writing and as a school we need to investigate how we can further support such groups of children.

Progress

- The most significant progress was in Mathematics where 45.5% of pupils made good progress and the least progress was in writing.
- 79% of PP children made at least satisfactory progress. Why wasn't that higher? How could we further improve that?
